This Block Course provides the opportunity to engage in an ongoing, in-depth, sustained study of the life of the Holy Spirit within the Bible, theology, and Christian history that will transform your approach to leadership, church, ministry, and life.

The life of the Spirit has been neglected in many ways, especially amongst Western Christianity, or it has been overemphasised in certain forms of Pentecostal theology. In the post-Enlightenment period the Spirit was confused with the human spirit which led to theologians either muting the Spirit (Barth) or losing the Spirit from the Father and the Son (liberal Christianity). As it relates to ministry, this course will help bridge the ancient/future divide.
