



## **Carey Baptist College Chinese Programme Scholarship**

### **Purpose**

The Scholarship is awarded to students enrolled the Chinese Programme on the basis of potential to contribute to mission and ministry, potential to succeed academically, and demonstrated financial hardship.

### **Eligibility**

To qualify for consideration of the award of a Scholarship, students will have met the following criteria:

- demonstrated contribution to the life and ministry of the church, with priority given to those serving within the Baptist Churches of New Zealand
- demonstrated academic potential/achievement
- demonstrated financial hardship
- demonstrated support for study from a suitable church leader.

### **Regulations**

- Students may apply directly for the Scholarship, or be nominated by a third party.
- The amount of a Scholarship will normally be up to fifty per cent of total annual Carey tuition fees (excluding student services fees).
- Scholarships will normally last for one academic year and students may apply for Scholarships in successive years of their studies.
- Scholarships may be cancelled after one semester of unsatisfactory work.
- Decisions to award Scholarships shall be made by the Scholarships Sub-Committee
- Carey reserves the right not to award a Scholarship in any given round.

### **Application deadline**

1 February (full year)

1 July (second semester intake)
