



Carey Baptist College Masters of Applied Theology Scholarship

Purpose

The scholarship is awarded to Master of Applied Theology thesis-based students on the basis of academic achievement and identified research areas of significant or special interest to Carey.

Eligibility

- Applicants will be graduates, engaged in or qualified to enter Carey's Master of Applied Theology programme.
- Priority will be given to those engaging in full-time study at Carey for a thesis-based Master of Applied Theology degree.
- Applicants will need to demonstrate academic achievement in their previous tertiary study
- Applicants will need engage in a research project identified by Carey as of significant or special interest.

Regulations

- In any given year a number of scholarships may be targeted towards specific research projects.
- The scholarship will normally cover the tuition fees for two semesters. In exceptional cases the tuition fees for up to three semesters of full-time study (including coursework) may be approved.
- Recipients may, from time to time, be required to assist faculty in marking or tutoring.
- Scholarships may be cancelled after one semester of unsatisfactory work.
- Decisions to award scholarships shall be made by the Scholarships Sub-Committee
- Carey reserves the right not to award a scholarship in any given round.

Application deadlines

1 February (full year)

1 July (second semester intake)
