



**Carey Baptist College**  
**Stewart Memorial Trust Scholarship**

**Purpose**

The scholarship is awarded to students enrolled in the Bachelor of Applied Theology programme on the basis of academic potential, and contribution to mission and ministry.

**Eligibility**

To qualify for consideration of the award of a scholarship, students will have met the following criteria:

- be able to show evidence of academic achievement in your secondary schooling, or previous tertiary study history in completed qualifications;
- demonstrate a high level of community involvement;
- demonstrate contribution to the life and ministry of the church. Priority may be given to those serving within the Open Brethren Churches of New Zealand, but it is not a pre-requisite.

**Regulations**

- The scholarship will normally be available only to full-time students who are not otherwise employed more than ten hours per week.
- The amount of the scholarship will normally be fifty per cent (50%) of total annual Carey tuition fees (excluding student services fees).
- The scholarship may be cancelled after one semester of unsatisfactory work.
- The scholarship will normally last for one academic year but students may apply for scholarships in successive years of their studies.
- Decisions to award a scholarship shall be made by the Scholarships Sub-Committee.
- Carey reserves the right not to award a scholarship in any given round.

**Application deadline**

1 February (full year)

1 July (second semester intake)
