



## **Carey Baptist College The Tab Trust Pioneer Ministry Grant**

### **Purpose**

The grant is awarded to students enrolled in a Carey programme of study and either the Diploma of Pastoral Leadership or the Diploma of Intercultural Practice, specialising in Pioneer Leadership. The purpose is to assist in the formational learning of reflective field education who meet the eligibility criteria

### **Eligibility**

To qualify for consideration of the award of a scholarship, students will have met the following criteria:

- enrolled in a pioneer leadership placement
- be based in one of the pioneer pods
- show evidence of academic achievement and a high level of community involvement
- demonstrate contribution to the life and ministry of the church

### **Regulations**

- Students may apply directly for the grant, or be nominated by a third party
- The scholarship will normally be available only to full-time students who are not otherwise employed more than ten hours per week.
- The amount of the scholarship will be determined on a case by case basis, dependant on applicant proposal, but normally agreed accommodation costs
- The scholarship may be cancelled after one semester of unsatisfactory work.
- The scholarship will normally last for one calendar year but students may apply for scholarships in successive years of their studies.
- Decisions to award a scholarship shall be made by the scholarships sub-committee
- Carey reserves the right not to award a scholarship in any given round.
