

Pastoral Leadership Accommodation Scholarships

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

Applicable study:	Diploma in Pastoral Leadership
Eligibility:	Students enrolled in the Diploma in Pastoral Leadership
Closing date:	1 December
Tenure:	One year
Value:	Up to \$10,000 for a family with one or more children Up to \$5000 for a married couple Up to \$2500 for an individual

DESCRIPTION

The main purpose of the Pastoral Leadership Accommodation Scholarships is to support students who have relocated to Auckland to complete the Diploma in Pastoral Leadership.

REGULATIONS

1. One or more scholarships may be awarded to an individual, each for a 12-month period (normally January- December), following applications. [See Note I]
2. The basis of selection will be:
 - a. meeting the criteria for entry into the Diploma of Pastoral Leadership
 - b. evidence of relocation to Auckland from another part of New Zealand [See Note II]
3. Priority will be given to domestic students who are in full-time enrolment in an academic programme alongside the Diploma in Pastoral Leadership. Part-time students who meet the criteria may also apply.
4. The Scholarship may be held with any other scholarship, award or grant as long as a) the terms of that scholarship, award or grant permit and b) Carey is informed and approves.

5. The Scholarships are awarded by Carey on the recommendation of the Scholarships Sub-Committee.
6. Carey is not obliged to award a Scholarship in any year there is no candidate who meets the criteria.
7. A recipient of the Scholarship may reapply in subsequent years (as per regulation 1 above).
8. Carey has the power to amend or vary these regulations, provided here is no departure from the main purpose of the Scholarship.

APPLICATION

Application should be made in writing to the Ministry Training department. The Ministry Training Department will nominate students who fulfil the criteria for consideration by the Scholarships Sub-Committee.

(Notes I-II below are deemed to be regulations)

- I. The Scholarship will normally be available only to full-time students who are not otherwise employed more than ten hours per week
- II. Payments under the terms of this Scholarship remain tax-free as long as they are used directly for the payment of costs associated with a student's programme of study. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in the termination of the Scholarship.
