

A student who has been prevented by illness or injury from being present at any examination or completing a final assessment or who considers that their performance in an examination in any course has been seriously impaired by illness or injury, may be granted an aegrotat pass in that course.

Application for an Aegrotat Pass must be made to the Academic Registrar within a week of the end of the semester in which the course was taken. The application must be supported by a medical certificate that states that in the practitioner's opinion, illness or injury of the student either prevented the candidate from taking the examination or completing the assessment on time or was likely to have seriously impaired performance in it.
