

Mission Scholarship

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

Applicable study:	Certificate of Christian Studies
Eligibility:	Applicants engaging with or preparing for intercultural mission
Closing date:	21 February (For Semester 1) 30 June (For Semester 2)
Tenure:	One year
Number on offer:	Up to 4 per year
Value:	Tuition fees rebate for one course

PURPOSE

The main purpose of the Mission Scholarship is supporting applicants preparing for, or engaged with, intercultural mission.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Applicants must be engaged with, or preparing for, intercultural mission
- Applicants must be endorsed by their Church leadership

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications must be made online or by filling out the Scholarship Application Form by either the 31st of Jan or 30th of June in the year of Scholarship.

SELECTION PROCESS

- 4 Scholarships are available annually.
- The scholarship is awarded by Carey scholarship committee comprising:
 - o Academic Director
 - o Academic Registrar
 - Lecturer, Mission and Bible
 - o Executive Director
- The committee will contact endorsing churches for reference purposes confirming their commitment to support their study

SELECTION CRITERIA

In making the recommendations, the selection committee considers, in descending order of priority, selected candidates:

- Must have demonstrated integrity, character and a demonstrated interest in intercultural mission
- Have a deep and sincere faith demonstrated in service to Church/community
- Have a desire to personally grow and prepare for intercultural mission/engagement through formal education
- Be able to navigate study and writing assessments in English (NZQA requirement)
- Must agree to regular meetings (*Classroom attendance*) and be committed to studying as part of a cohort of learners during the teaching semester.

REGULATIONS

- The scholarship will cover a maximum of 1 undergraduate course for 2023. There is no guarantee of future scholarships.
- Payments under the terms of this Scholarship remain tax-free as long as they are used directly for the payment of costs associated with a Scholar's programme of study. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in the termination of the Scholarship.
- Applicants must not be eligible for Fees Free in their year of study.
- The Scholarships are tenable by domestic students only.
- The Scholarship committee has the power to terminate or suspend a Scholarship if it receives an unsatisfactory report on the progress of a Scholar from the Academic Director.
- Carey is not obliged to award a Scholarship in any year there is no candidate of sufficient merit.
- A recipient of the Scholarship may reapply in subsequent years.
- Carey has the power to amend or vary these regulations, provided there is no departure from the main purpose of the Scholarship.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE AND DETAILS

- A maximum of four scholarships will be awarded, each for a period of one year, in the form
 of a tuition fee rebate up to the value of one course for the year of study for which the
 Scholarship is made. No monies will be paid to the student.
- The Scholarships are tenable to successful students who have paid the fees, or arranged to pay the fees, for enrolment in undergraduate study at Carey Baptist College
