



Carey Kickstart Scholarship

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

Applicable study:	Any level 5 course offered as part of the New Zealand Certificate of Christian Studies in Semester Two, 2023
Eligibility:	Applicants who have not studied at Carey Baptist College previously with a sincere and demonstrated commitment to their faith
Closing date:	30 June 2023 (for Semester 2 2023 intake only)
Tenure:	One semester
Number on offer:	Up to fifty (50)
Value:	Tuition fees rebate for one course

PURPOSE

The main purpose of the Kickstart Scholarship is supporting applicants who are new to theological or biblical study into one course of study in Semester 2, 2023, with a view to completing the NZ Certificate in Christian Studies (or other approved Carey qualification).

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- These scholarships are tenable by domestic students for enrolment in Semester 2, 2023
- Applicants must not have been enrolled previously at Carey Baptist College
- Applicants must not be eligible for the Government's Fees-Free Scheme

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications must be made online or by filling out the Scholarship Application Form by 30 June in the year of Scholarship.

SELECTION PROCESS

- The scholarship is awarded by Carey scholarship committee comprising:
 - Academic Director
 - Academic Registrar
 - Executive Director

SELECTION CRITERIA

In making the recommendations, the selection committee considers, in descending order of priority, selected candidates who:

- Have a deep and sincere faith demonstrated in service to Church/community
- Have a desire to personally grow in their faith
- Demonstrate the willingness and potential to successfully complete a course of study
- Be able to navigate study and writing assessments in English (*NZQA requirement*)

REGULATIONS

- The scholarship will cover a maximum of one undergraduate course for Semester 2, 2023. A recipient of the Scholarship may reapply in subsequent years but there is no guarantee of further scholarships.
- Applicants must not be eligible for the Government's Fees Free scheme (see <https://www.feesfree.govt.nz>)
- Applicants must not have previously enrolled at Carey Baptist College.
- The Scholarships are tenable by domestic students only.
- Carey is not obliged to award a Scholarship in any given year if there is no candidate of sufficient merit.
- Payments under the terms of this Scholarship remain tax-free as long as they are used directly for the payment of costs associated with a Scholar's programme of study. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in the termination of the Scholarship.
- Carey has the power to amend or vary these regulations, provided there is no departure from the main purpose of the Scholarship.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE AND DETAILS

- A maximum of fifty scholarships will be awarded in the form of a tuition fee rebate up to the value of one course for Semester 2, 2023 only. No monies will be paid to the student.
