ABOUT KICKSTART SCHOLARSHIPS

Applicable study:	Any level 5 course offered as part of the New Zealand Certificate of Christian Studies (or other approved qualification) in semester two 2023
Eligibility:	Applicants who have not studied at Carey Baptist College previously
Closing date:	30 June 2023 (for semester two 2023 intake only)
Tenure:	One semester
Number on offer:	Up to 50
Value:	Tuition fees rebate for one course

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- These scholarships are tenable by domestic students only for enrollment at Carey Baptist College semester two 2023.
- Applicants must not have been enrolled at Carey previously.
- Applicants must not be eligible for the Government's Fees Free scheme.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE AND DETAILS

- Scholarships will be awarded in the form of a tuition fee rebate up to the value of one course for semester two 2023 only. No monies will be paid directly to the student.

Applications must be made by completing the Scholarship Application Form by 30 June 2023

SELECTION PROCESS

The scholarship is awarded by the Carey Scholarships Committee comprising:

- o Academic Director
- o Academic Registrar
- o Executive Director

SELECTION CRITERIA

In making the recommendations, the selection committee considers, in descending order of priority, selected candidates who:

- Have a deep and sincere faith demonstrated in service to Church/community.
- Have a desire to personally grow in their faith.
- Demonstrate the willingness and potential to successfully complete a course of study.
- Are able to navigate study and writing assessments in English (NZQA requirement).

REGULATIONS

- The Kickstart Scholarship will cover a maximum of one undergraduate course for semester two 2023. A recipient of the Scholarship may reapply in subsequent years but there is no guarantee of further scholarships.
- Applicants must not be eligible for the Government's Fees Free scheme (see <https://www.feesfree.govt.nz>).
- Applicant must not have previously enrolled at Carey Baptist College.
- The Scholarships are tenable by domestic students only.
- Carey is not obliged to award a Scholarship in any given year if there are no candidates of sufficient merit.
- Payments under the terms of this Scholarship remain tax-free as long as they are used directly for the payment of costs associated with a Scholar's programme of study. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in the termination of the Scholarship.
- Carey has the authority to amend or vary these regulations, provided there is no departure from the main purpose of the Scholarship.
