

Carey Achiever Scholarship

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

Applicable study:	Any course offered as part of the Bachelor of Applied Theology or Graduate Diploma of Applied Theology
Closing date:	31 January, 30 June in the year of scholarship
Tenure:	One semester
Number on offer:	Up to six (6)
Value:	Tuition fees rebate for one course

PURPOSE

The main purpose of the Achiever Scholarship is to support high-achieving applicants to complete the Bachelor of Applied Theology or the Graduate Diploma of Applied Theology.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

These scholarships are tenable by domestic students, who:

- are enrolling in a minimum of two courses per semester in the Bachelor of Applied Theology or the Graduate Diploma of Applied Theology
- have completed a relevant undergraduate qualification with a grade average of A- across all courses
- meet the programme requirements
- show a deep and sincere faith demonstrated in service to Church/community and a desire to personally grow in their faith

APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCESS

Applications must be made online or by filling out the Scholarship Application Form by the closing date. Scholarships are managed and awarded by the Carey Scholarships Committee.

REGULATIONS

- The Scholarships are tenable by domestic students only.
- Applicants must be ineligible for the Government's Fees Free scheme (see https://www.feesfree.govt.nz).
- Applicants must be enrolled in a course in either the Bachelor of Applied Theology or the Graduate Diploma of Applied Theology at Carey Baptist College.
- The scholarship will cover a maximum of one undergraduate course. A recipient of the

- Scholarship may reapply in subsequent years but there is no guarantee of further scholarships.
- Applicants must have previously successfully completed tertiary courses proving the ability to complete a level 7 qualification.
- Carey is not obliged to award a Scholarship in any given year if there is no candidate of sufficient merit.
- Payments under the terms of this Scholarship remain tax-free as long as they are used directly for the payment of costs associated with a Scholar's programme of study. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in the termination of the Scholarship.
- Carey has the power to amend or vary these regulations, provided there is no departure from the main purpose of the Scholarship.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE AND DETAILS

• A maximum of six scholarships will be awarded in the form of a tuition fee rebate up to the value of one course at Carey Baptist College. No monies will be paid to the student.
